Camps are coming in June. A few of us leaders are organizing those events, as we're still missing a Pack 126 camping coordinator. Give it some thought - a great way to help the pack go

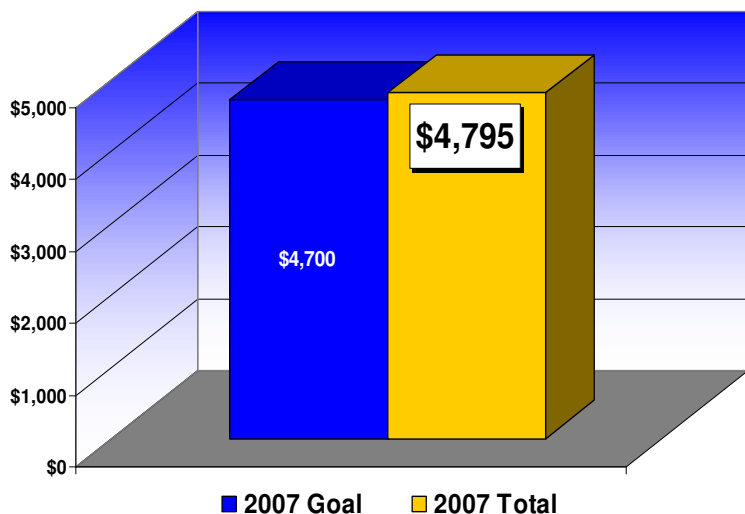
It's going to be a great Summer and a great scouting year!!
